Morgan's Training Tips

Using a rope halter is preferable to using a nylon halter. The thick nylon is heavy on a horse's poll (behind the ears) and nose. The weight makes a horse dull and insensitive to pressure in the areas that he needs to be sensitive in so he can respond to slight pressure. A basic principle of training a horse is moving away from pressure. Leading properly is one of the first ways a horse learns this concept. Every time you handle a horse, you are training him whether you mean to or not.

Each time we handle a horse, we ask them to drop their head from a light pressure on the nose piece of the halter. This creates pressure on the poll and the horse learns daily how to move away from pressure. This will be a foundation for other areas of training where the horse will learn how to move away from pressure when applied on any part of the body.

HPAF Interior Fencing Project Completed

After months of construction, HPAF has all new interior fences on the farm. Finally, all of the old, rotting fence is gone, replaced by beautiful, safe board fencing. The project, which has been in the plans for years, began on December 24th, 2005. A limerock road was created in order to access pastures which are generally not accessible in the wet season. Over the span of six weeks, old fences were removed, loaded into a dumpster and carted away forever. New fencing was installed and then painted. This project was made possible by Ardath Rosengarden and the Ralph & Ardath Rosengarden Foundation. Our most sincere gratitude goes out to Ardath for her long time support of HPAF and the deserving horses we care for. Thanks also to the William and Charlotte Parks Foundation for Animal Welfare that contributed a grant for a portion of the fencing.
